With more participation than we have ever had before, we have reached, and surpassed(!!), our goal of \$125,000 in parent donations! We had a flurry of last minute donations (including one large gift that put us over the top), and for the last 50 days, every single donation was matched dollar for dollar by our 10 families who so generously gave \$5,000 each (such a special thank you to the following families: Nicholas, Roberts, Leddy, Geier, Hnatek, Winter/Flicker, Beacham, Camarena, Schroeder, and an anonymous donor).

To put this into perspective, this is almost 300% more than we raised only 3 years ago. It's truly incredible.
